Introduction

Avery 440 Gloss Transparent is a multi-purpose screenprint film for a wide variety of relatively short-term applications. It is available with different adhesives and liners to suit specific uses.

^{*} Scored Backing liner consists out of liner with crush-scored lines, running in the machine direction, <u>50 mm</u> apart. Bending along one of the lines will crack the backing open for easy removal. The functionality of scored backing products is strongly related to the size of the graphic (sticker, labeletc.). We advise not to use scored backing for graphics larger than A4 (210 x 297 mm) or smaller than A8 (52 x 74 mm). Also the direction of the scorelines is of importance; for graphics from A8 to A6 (105x 148 mm) it is recommended to have the scorelines parallel to the short side of the label. For products not complying to these recommendations Avery Dennison does not take responsibility for the functionality of the scorelines.

Features

Avery 440 Gloss Transparent features excellent conversion and printing characteristics: it can be screenprinted with most common screen inks for self-adhesive films. Avery 440 Gloss Transparent has excellent layflatness and dimensional stability properties to ensure high output and exact registered prints. For screen ink recommendations: consult Avery Technical Bulletin No. 2.2. Avery 440 Gloss Transparent has excellent outdoor exposure properties.
